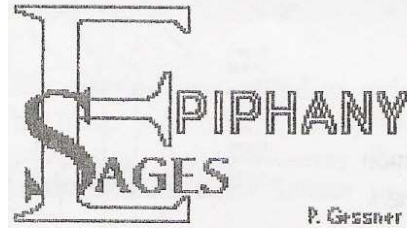
Core Team Meetings

## **Core Team Minutes: Jan. 13, 2009**

George Hagman convened the meeting at 12:30pm. Those present: Carl Trimble, Marge McGrath, George Hagman, Corine Liebert, Mil/Norm Buckley, Mary Ann Calle', Dot Zipperle, Wilma Valentine, Dianne Scheer, Freda Adiletto, and Dennis Keller.

The meeting began with an opening prayer by Wilma Valentine.

The December Minutes were approved (Carl Trimble/Marge McGrath).

Treasurer Carl Trimble: the Sages budget for 2009-2010 is \$1410.00. There was no income and no expenses for Dec-Jan. Income (YTD) is \$285.00 and expenses (YTD) of \$893.03. The balance of available funds is \$801.97.
