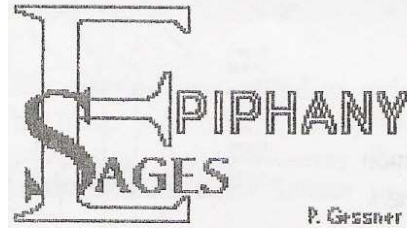
Core Team Meetings
