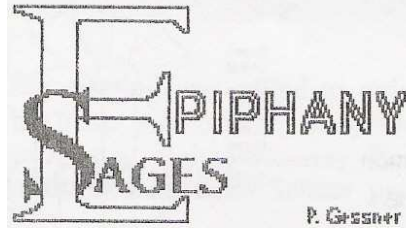
Core Team Meetings

The April, 2010 Minutes were approved.

Treasurer: Carl Trimble. The Sages budget for 2009-2010 is \$1410.00. The income for Apr-May was \$71.00 and the expenses were \$199.40. Member donations at the April meeting were \$71.00 and expenses were \$75.00. Income (YTD) is \$807.00 and expenses (YTD) of \$1579.01. The balance of available funds is \$637.39.
