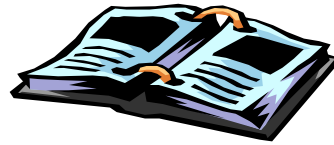
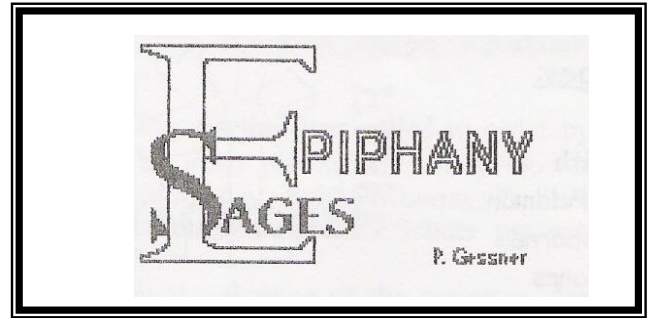
Core Team Meetings
